

# CIVIL SEIZURES

## Description

In June 1997, the vehicle impounding ordinance number 97-4002 was enacted, providing for the impounding of vehicles used to facilitate prostitution or drug related crimes. This process differs from vehicle or other property confiscation in that a vehicle may be impounded when probable cause exists, whereas confiscation may occur only after proof in court and with the illegal use occurring with owner knowledge. Impounded vehicles may be regained by owners, but confiscated property is used by law enforcement under terms of applicable law and regulation.
