



Priority: E. QUALITY OF LIFE

Measurable Objectives:

1. **Community Policing:** Develop written community oriented police strategies that target resources and optimize visibility in most needed areas of City. (2010)
2. **Five Points Park:** Increase activity in 5 Points Park to make it a family/community gathering place. Review opportunities for a weekly or monthly community celebration in the park. (2010)
3. **Social Infrastructure:** Develop an allocation plan for allocating a percentage of TIF and Police seized funds for “social infrastructure” activities in the Greater Newtown Community. (2010)
4. **Level of Service:** Develop five to ten level of service indicators that correlate with the public’s perception of level of service. (2010)
5. **Police Panel Recommendations:** Implement key recommendations of the Police Advisory Panel adopted by Commission for improved City of Sarasota policing efforts. (2010)
6. **Payne Park Phase 2:** Present a plan for partial funding of Payne Park Phase 2. Plan should identify opportunities to increase Park users and activity levels. (2010)
7. **Youth Empowerment:** Continue to provide support for youth empowerment/job programs such as Yelda, Man-Up and the Greatness Beyond Measure Teen Summit. (2010, 2011)
8. **Labor Force improvements:** Spearhead or support initiatives for the educational and employment advancement of adults in the Newtown community.(2010, 2011)
9. **Information Management:** Proactively utilize the Public Information team to inform and educate the public in a manner that supports and promotes the City’s vision, goals and achievements. (2010, 2011)
10. **Homelessness in Downtown:** Research the impact of unresolved homelessness on the vitality of Downtown, identify innovative strategies to address same issues by other municipalities, identify any possible funding opportunities and strategize solutions to issues. (2010, 2011) Include in review:
 - a. Fund or support an established ‘Day Facility’ for Homeless Adults
 - b. Increase penalties for repeat offenders and consider adoption of a work program for same.
11. **Increase public access to waterfront:** Develop an inventory of public “rights of way” and City owned lands which terminate at the water’s edge (Gulf, Bay and/or Bayou) and review opportunities for creating public access points to the water. (2010, 2011)
12. **Citizens Survey:** Benchmark our City against other Florida Cities and report results to Commission. (2011)
