

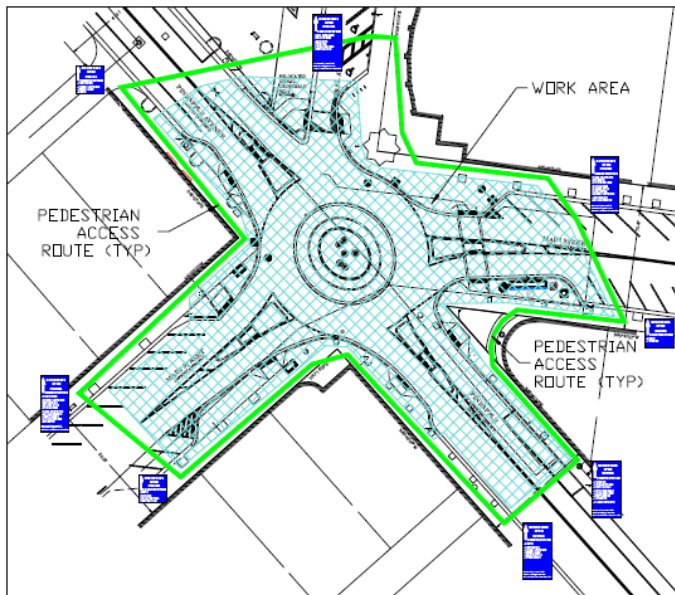

On behalf of City staff, we want to wish you a happy and safe July 4th. Main Street is the place to be for the festivities this weekend. For those that will be working over the holiday, an extra special thank you to you and your family for making our downtown experience enjoyable.



On July 5, Phase II of the Five Points Roundabout construction begins. Jon F. Swift, our contractor, will be closing the Five Points intersection to vehicular traffic at 5:00 a.m. Monday morning. The first order of business will be to install the fence around the area. Pedestrian traffic will be maintained with directional signage to businesses erected. Demolition of pavement will commence along with the removal of the traffic signal. The contractor will be working day and night shifts in order to complete the roundabout on or before September 3, 2010.

Valet parking hours will be extended during this phase of the work: Monday through Thursday, 11 a.m. to 10 p.m., Friday and Saturday, 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.

We appreciate the cooperation and patience the business owners and residents have shown through the course of the downtown improvements. Your efforts are shown as the downtown continues, and will forever, be the place to “Stroll, Dine, and Shop”.
