Most *Intersections* artists are from the surrounding area while several are from the Southeast and Midwest. Their experience ranges from emerging artist to advanced professional and their work varies widely – from ornamental to brutal expressionism to constructivist. The intent is that there is a little something for everyone.

Throughout the tour, you will weave through and around the five downtown shopping districts, each with its own color and character. Each offers an interesting selection of restaurants, shops, galleries and performing venues.

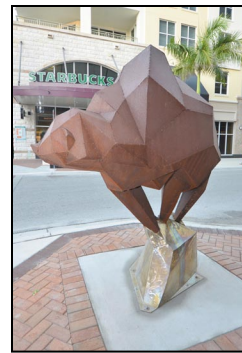
This walking tour can last an hour or be spread over several visits, including one or more of the many amenities our unique downtown Sarasota has to offer.

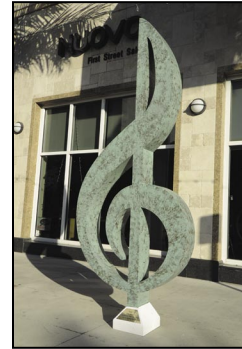

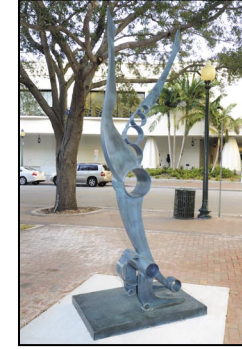
